Race Location:

Tipton Lakes Marina 6000 Tipton Lakes Blvd Columbus, IN 47201

Parking:

Parking will be provided along the streets of Tipton Lakes Neighborhood. Please be respectful to neighbors and do not block driveways or park on the grass.

Transition/Race Details:

Transition will be located in the Tipton Lakes Marina parking lot. Transition opens at 6:30 am and will close at 7:45 am. Please report to that location with your bike upon arriving. There will be a registration tent where you will need to check in to get your race bib. Body marking and timing chips will be located in the middle of transition.

Helmets are required to race. NO helmet - no race. Helmets must be worn anytime you are on your bike - including before and after the race. A USAT official will be on site and this could result in a time penalty. If you hop on your bike from your vehicle to transition, put on your helmet.

The transition will be closed off once the race begins. Spectators will not be allowed in transition during the race.

Race Bibs will need to be worn during the run portion of the race.

Water stops will be provided on the run portion of the race. Water and Gatorade will be available at the water stations.

Duathletes will run and bike the sprint course. Duathlon start is at the finish line.

Timing:

The race will be timed by Racemaker Productions using timing chips. Results will be posted after the race on runcolumbus.org as well as on our event facebook page.

The swim is a time trial start. Swimmers will enter the water based on their swimming ability. A swimmer will enter the water every 3 seconds. Swim caps will be provided and are required. Lifeguards will be on boats throughout the swim course.

Spectators:

Families are encouraged to attend. Please remember to bring chairs.

Awards:

The top overall male and female finishers will receive an award. We will also give awards to the top 3 male and female age group finishers for the triathlon, duathlon, teams, clydesdale and athena divisions.

Based on USAT requirements, age is based on the participant's age as of December 31, 2024.

Post Race Food:

Post race snacks will be provided for the participants.
